Three Forms of Murder.

- Coarse Form:
- a. Murdering with your own hands. Cain, Gen. 4:8
- b. Murdering others through another person: David II Samuel 11:5
- c. Murdering through carelessness Ex. 21:9, Deut. 22:8
- d. Self Murder (Suicide) Matthew 27:5

Three Forms of Murder

2. Finer Form:

- a. Shorten or embitter life. Gen. 37:23-35
- b. Harm or hurt in body. Matt 26:51
- c. Depriving one of food, cloths or home to cause death.

No Divorce

- Only 2 Reasons for Divorce
- Unfaithfulness (Adultery)
- Desertion by an unbelieving partner
- Adultery: 1) <u>WIDE SENSE</u> sexual intercourse with someone you are not married to. Adultery:
- 2) <u>NARROW SENSE</u> sexual intercourse with someone you are not married to, but you or the other person *is* married to someone else.


- Birth Control
- 1. Is not sinful <u>if</u> it prevents the egg and sperm from contact (i.e., prevents fertilization / conception).
- Is sinful <u>if</u> it allows conception, but a not pregnancy.

3. Abortion: Is NOT birth control, but a form of murder.

- Never go on car dates where you would end up in dangerous situations.






























 <u>Gossip / Slander</u> - trying to build up ourselves by putting someone else down with lies, half-truths, or hurtful information.




