



It is called the Apostles' Creed, not because it was written by the apostles themselves, but because it states briefly the doctrine (teaching) which God gave through the apostles in the Bible. The Creed is trinitarian because the Scriptures reveal God as triune. Christians are baptized in the name of the triune God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

The Apostle's Creed is very old. From the bible and the church fa s, (Men who led the church during the end of the first 100 years of the Christian Church through about 500 AD) we learn that candidates for Baptism were required to make confession of their faith and state briefly what they believed regarding God the Creator, Jesus the Savior, and the Holy Ghost the Sanctifier and some such form as we now use was undoubtedly in use. The Creed is an amplification of the Trinitarian formula of Baptism. The word "Creed" is from the Latin word "Credo" meaning " I Believe. The First Article - Creation I Believe in God the Father Almighty maker of heaven and earth. What does this mean? I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them. The First Article - Creation He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with al that I need to support this body and life. He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him.

This is most certainly true.

You must be convinced by the bible that the statements contained in the Apostles Creed are truth.

Where is the Truth? •Jesus said in John 17:17, "Sanctify them by the truth; your word is the truth." Here is where you find the truth. Only in the bible will you find the truth that will lead to eternal truths and eternal life. —Your Fathers faith can not save you! —Your Mothers faith can not save you!

Evil Angels All angels were holy-until: War and rebellion in heaven – see Is 14:12 and Rev. 12: 1-9 Satan or Lucifer fell and in his fall he took one third of all the created angels with him. Now called 'demons'.

Evil Angels See Jude 6– Angels that left their first estate or home. God did not create the devil, he made himself. How? By rebellion.

Evil Angels

They are now enemies of God and man. See Peter, Satan roaming around as a roaring lion seeking people to destroy. Turn to I Peter 5:8

They are also called, "powers of darkness". Fallen angels are many in number, cunning, powerful, evil. They are not to be played with...Most of all they are real.
